

Initiator and Driving Force

Francis Van Loon (Photo) studied social sciences at the University of Ghent (Belgium) and Emory University in Atlanta (USA). He became professor at the UFSIA in Antwerp, where he also served as the dean of the Faculty of Political and Social Sciences. He then assumed the role of rector at the Confederated University Antwerp and later became the first rector of the unified University of Antwerp. In 2008, he was granted the title of Baron by King Albert II of Belgium. In 2016, he was appointed Grand Officer of the Order of Leopold.
